

APPLYING FOR THE PORTAGE COUNTY LOTTERY AND GAMING CREDIT

If you received a Lottery Credit on your 2014 tax bill, and have not changed primary residences, you will automatically receive the Lottery and Gaming Credit on your 2015, real estate tax bill, which will be mailed in December 2015.

General application for Lottery and Gaming Credit occurs every five years. The next general application will occur in 2019. You need not file another application until then unless your residence changes.

You may claim a Lottery and Gaming Credit for 2015 taxes, payable in 2016, if on January 1, 2015, you were an owner of the property and used that property as your primary residence. Your primary residence is where you live most of the time. You can have only one primary residence, and **you may only claim one credit. The Wisconsin Department of Revenue will audit all claims.**
